Assessment Center – Provides FCC placement, ability to benefit (financial aid) assistance, and computer familiarity testing. For a nominal fee, they proctor exams for online/distance learning/correspondence courses taught by other institutions. Located in LI-145. For more information, please call 442-8280. CalWORKs – Offers assistance to students eligible to participate in the CalWORKs program. Support services may include: child care, book vouchers, and academic counseling. Located in T-201. For details, please call 442-8286.

Career Center – Offers assistance to students in their selection of a career. Support services may include: career assessments, career planning guidance, and computer based career information. Located upstairs in the Student Services building. For details, please call 442-8294.
